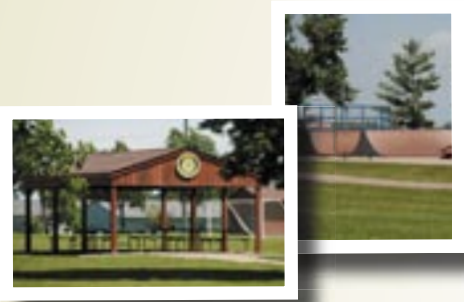

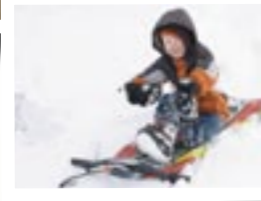

Fun at Oak Leaf Park!



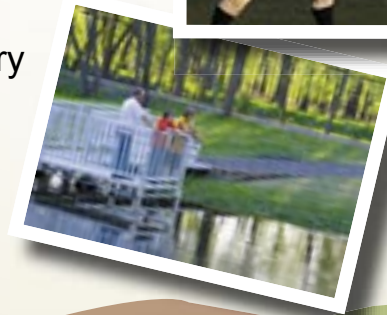
The Glencoe Parks and Recreation Department includes Oak Leaf Park, The Glencoe Aquatic Center, Oscar Olson Park, Lincoln Park, Glen Knoll Park, Welcome Park, the Horseshoe Parks, the Buffalo Creek BMX Park, and the outdoor skating rink at the end of Greeley Avenue.

OAK LEAF PARK

200 Desoto Avenue South

Oak Leaf Park is Glencoe's Flagship Park, comprised of thirty-eight acres and countless opportunities for family fun. Park amenities include the Glencoe Aquatic Center, shaded picnic areas, fishing pond, children's play areas, disc golf course, soft-ball and baseball fields, sand volleyball court, soccer field, basketball court, horseshoe pits, walking paths, camping spots and more. The park has five park shelters available for rent. The Glencoe Aquatic Center and Wildlife Sanctuary are located at the park.

Many of Glencoe's annual events such as Glencoe Days, Dairy Day, and the Wood Bat Tournament are held at Oak Leaf Park.



GLENCOE AQUATIC CENTER

The Glencoe Aquatic Center is a premium outdoor swimming facility, drawing visitors from throughout the region. Featuring a 150-foot flume slide, zero entrance pool, diving boards, concessions, sand pit, sand volleyball court and shaded areas, the pool is a prime location for family enjoyment and warm weather relief! The Glencoe Aquatic Center is located in the heart of Oak Leaf Park.

WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Located at the southwest end of the park, the Glencoe Wildlife Sanctuary offers stunning close-up observation of elk, deer, peacocks, waterfowl and llamas. A walking path surrounds the 32-acre grounds. Don't forget an apple or carrots, as the elk will enjoy this treat at the fence!

CAMPING AT THE PARK

Six camping spots are located at the south end of the park with electricity available. Water, sewer and fire rings are not available. Tent camping is prohibited. Campers can self pay on-site, \$15.00 per night. Grill areas and restrooms are available in the park. Camping is first come, first serve. Reservations are not accepted.
