The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Voss.

7. REQUESTS TO BE HEARD

A. Pickleball Courts Request for funding – Mayor Voss

Mayor Voss presented a proposal to construct a 4-net Pickleball Court in Oscar Olson Park at an estimated cost of \$120,000 to \$150,00. He noted that the Park Board had recommended up to \$100,000 in Park Improvement Funds (PIF) be used for the project. Currently there is \$178,000 in the PIF with designated funding from the Sno Pros and Lions for Pickleball at \$14,000.

Councilor Neid asked about the need for the additional pickleball facilities with the GSL High School Tennis Courts so close to Oscar Olson Park. He questioned using that much PIF monies toward the project; he felt there should be more donation. Olson noted the work done to date.

Neid recommended up a 50/50 match with a maximum of \$75,000 in PIF monies be designated for Pickleball, as there are many other projects that will be requesting funding from the PIF

Motion: Neid, seconded by Rivera. All in favor, the motion carried.

B. Appoint Lynda Wagoner to Park Board

Motion: Neid, seconded by Olson. All in favor, the motion carried.

A. Emerald - Ash Borer update – PW Director Voigt updated the City Council and confirmed that the Emerald Ash Borer had been positively identified in Glencoe. He discussed the need to conduct an inventory of boulevard ash trees and trees on public property. He would be bringing more information to the City Council as it became available.

Special Event Guidelines

Special events include walk/runs, tournaments, concerts or gatherings of 50 participants or more in the City of Glencoe. Special Event Applications must be submitted at least 30 calendar days prior the event. Below is a list of additional items that may be required for your event, please review carefully.

Certificate of Liability Insurance: The City of Giencoe, at its discretion, may require the applicant to obtain a certificate of Liability Insurance. If required, applicants must provide a minimum of \$1,000,000 of general liability coverage for each occurrence and shall name the City of Giencoe as an additional insured. Based on special event activities, some events may be required to obtain additional coverage. If you don't have private insurance or your organization does not have insurance, you may obtain insurance through the League of MN Cities Tenant User Liability Insurance Program (TULIP). Information on TULIP is located online at: www.lmc.org

Alcohol: If alcohol is sold or provided, the event must have proper licensing through State of MN and City of Glencoe. Liquor Liability Insurance is required for events that sell or provide alcohol.

Security: If the Chief of Police determines security is needed for the event, the organizer will be charged an hourly rate per officer as set by the City's fee schedule.

Street Closures: If a street closure occurs along residential streets, reasonable efforts must be made to alert all property owners along the street of the proposed closure. Failure to notify property owners in street closure areas or gain approval of street closures will result in revocation of permit.

Garbage: Organizers may be required to provide garbage containers and removal depending on the size of the event and the number of participants.

Sanitary Restrooms: Organizers may be required to provide sanitary restrooms depending on the size of the event and the number of participants.

Directional Markers: No paint or chalk paint should be used as directional markers on the trail systems in the parks or on the sidewalks and streets. Suggestions for directional markers include cones, sidewalk chalk, small signs or volunteers. Renter will be charged a fee if paint or permanent marks are placed on the trail system, sidewalks or streets. If you need cones or other materials from the Street Department, please make sure to include these items in the assistance requested section.

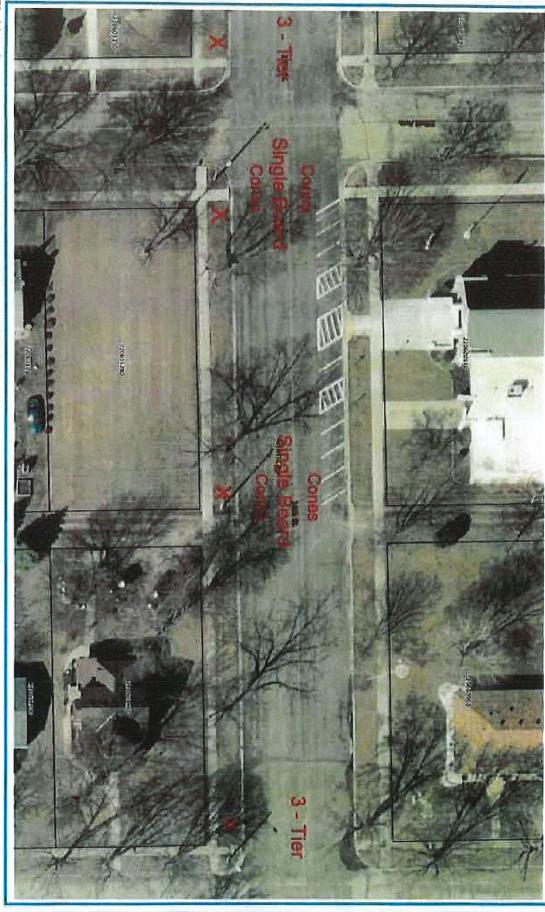

Pickup for Public Works

The City of Glencoe Street/Park Department is requesting the purchase of a 2024 ½ ton pickup to replace the 1998 Chevrolet extended cab 1500 4x4 pickup. The Street/Park Department budgeted for a pickup replacement in 2024.

I looked into 2024 State contracting specification and pricing for a Chevrolet and Ford along with matching specs from the same vehicles that was presented to the City Council from Wastewater last year. I found out that the Ford XL has more issues with delays in delivery; and, the Ford XLT has no issues, so after talking to the City Administrator, I decided to quote the XLT. I forwarded that information to Paul Harpel at Weelborg Chevrolet, and to Mike Schuetz at Morries Buffalo Ford (Light and Power has purchased from Morries in the past). The City and Light and Power have been satisfied with the service provided by both dealers.

Regarding specifications, I needed to add features to both vehicles to make them comparable. Also, the Ford is not considered a fleet vehicle (with more options), and the Chevrolet is considered a fleet vehicle. Below is the cost to purchase a truck from each dealer:

Weelborg Chevrolet – Chevrolet Silverado 1500 \$47,890.70

Morries Buffalo Ford – Ford F150 XLT \$49,485.22
