1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND MOMENT OF SILENCE

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Voss.

2. CONSENT AGENDA

A. Approve Minutes of the Regular Meeting of November 18, 2024 **Motion:** Lemke, seconded by Neid to approve the consent agenda. All in favor, the motion carries.

3. APPROVE AGENDA

Motion: Neid, seconded by Hueser to approve the agenda. All in favor, the motion carries.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT (agenda items only)

5. PUBLIC HEARINGS

A. Truth in Taxation Public Hearing at 7:15 PM – City Administrator At this time, Mayor Voss opened the public hearing on Truth in Taxation. City Administrator Mark Larson reviewed the proposed 2025 Property Tax Levy with the City Council and the public.

Motion: With no Public comment, Lemke made a motion to close the public hearing. Seconded by Hueser, with all in favor, the motion carried.

B. Set Tax Abatement Public Hearing with Apollo Development for January 6th, 2025, at 7:00.

It is the recommendation of the EDA to set a public hearing for Tax Abatement for the City portion of taxes for the development of a Hotel with Apollo Development for January 6th at 7:00 PM.

Motion: Hueser, seconded by Rivera to set the public hearing for Tax Abatement for January 6, 2025, at 7:00 PM. All in favor, the motion carries.

6. BIDS AND QUOTES

A. Quote for 2025 Fire Grass Rig – Side-by-side Gator and Trailer – Public Safety Funds – Fire Chief Scheidt

Chief Scheidt and the Fire Department have completed research to find a 2025 Fire ATV Grass Firefighting vehicle. The attached quote is from Midwest Machinery for the purchase of a 2025 Gator with the IAS Firefighting package. The total package is \$100,000.00. They have presented this to the Townships and have received their approval to participate in the vehicle purchase. The cost to the City is \$68,356.94. It is recommended to approve the quote of Midwest Machinery for the ATV Firefighting package.

Motion: Hueser, seconded by Lemke to approve the purchase of the side-by-side Gator from Midwest Machinery. All in favor, the motion carries.

The City of Glencoe also received a donation from Rich Valley Township of \$10,000.00 to be used to offset the cost of the ATV Fire package. We received a quote from Central Trailer Sales in East Bethel for \$7,799.00. A quote from Outlet Dock and Trailer for \$6,670.00 It is recommended to approve the quote of Midwest Machinery for the ATV Firefighting package. The funds for the purchase would be from the Public Safety Grant Funds.

Motion: Neid, seconded by Rivera to approve the purchase of the trailer from Outlet Dock and Trailer. All in favor, the motion carries.

B. Quote for Training Room Tables and Chairs – Public Safety Funds – Police Chief Padilla

Chief Padilla reviews the attached recommendation to purchase tables, chairs, and an interactive TV for the Conference Room at the Police Department. The funding will be made from the available fund from the 2024 Public Safety Grant. In effort to start the build of an Emergency Operation Center (EOC). The following items are being requested; 10 tables, 20 chairs, and 1 mobile flat board interactive TV.

Motion: Neid, seconded by Hueser to table the purchase of tables, chair, and flat board TV until other quotes are received. All in favor, the motion carries.

- C. Quotes for Property Demolition 1206 10th Street East and 1207 Chandler Avenue North City Administrator
 - Quotes were presented at the last City council meeting for demolition on 1206 10th Street East and 1207 Chandler Avenue North. The cost will be assessed back to the properties including the hazard mitigation, legal fees, and the demolition. It is not a fast process. As the City, we are sometimes stuck with issues like this that are not very attractive nor benefit the City as a whole.
- **D.** 1234 Greeley Avenue North City Administrator and City Attorney

- 1. Braun Intertec quote for Pre-Demolition Hazardous Property Materials Inspection City Administrator
- 2. Request to purchase adjoining property at 712 13th Street East City Administrator

The process has gone from 5 years down to 3 years. City Attorney Ostlund spoke with the County. 1234 Greeley is 5 years plus behind on property taxes. The County is making it sound like this property will go to Tax forfeiture sale this year. If we choose to acquire the property for a dollar, we are limited on what we can do with the property. We want this property redeveloped. City has made the decision that acquiring a tax forfeited, for under fair market value, is not going to further our interest.

Unfortunately, at this time, the City of Glencoe will not own 1234 Greeley, when demolished, unless other arrangements can be made.

E. Airport Pavement Maintenance and A/D Fence Design – Airport Commission It is the recommendation of the Airport Commission to enter into contract with SEH for the design work involved in the Airport Maintenance (Sealcoat) and A/D Fence Design. The total cost for this design is \$7,700. The FAA will pay 95%, the State of MN 2.5%, and the local share is 2.5%. The local share is \$192.50. The project will be constructed in 2026.

Motion: Lemke, seconded by Rivera to approve the airport pavement and maintenance and A/D Fence Design. All in favor, the motion carries.

F. 2025 Taxilane and Taxilane Extension – Airport Commission It is the recommendation of the Airport Commission to enter contract with SEH for the design work involved in the new Taxilane and Taxilane Extension. This will allow for additional private hangars to be constructed at the Glencoe Airport. The total cost for this design is \$99,400.00. The FAA will pay 95%, the State of MN 2.5%, and the local share is \$2.485.00.

Motion: Neid, seconded by Hueser to approve the new Taxilane and Taxilane Extension project at the Glencoe Airport. All in favor, the motion carries.

B. Awning/Sign Grant for Scharpe, LTD at 1221 Greeley Avenue North – EDA Recommendation

Motion: Neid, seconded by Rivera to approve the Awning Grant request for Scharpe, LTD. All in favor, the motion carries.

City Attorney Mark Ostlund reviewed the attached Cannabis Ordinance update. This is required since McLeod County has now completed their ordinance. January 1, 2025 is stated as the first day one could apply for licenses at the State level.

I've attached five quotes for new tables and chairs at the request of the last council meeting. The average cost of the five quotes is \$10,990.76 for 10 tables and 20 chairs. I'm requesting \$9,949.00 to purchase product.

I would like approval to purchase tables from National Business Furniture (NBF) in the amount of \$6,149 and chairs from ULINE in the amount of \$3,200. The combined total for the purchase is roughly \$9,949.00. (estimated shipping at \$600 total for both items)

I'm requesting to purchase the tables from NBF because their tables don't have a modesty skirt on them. I've been told the skirt can be removed from one vendor (ULINE) but I'm not sure if that effects the structural integrity of the table or if you would still see parts on the table that are designed to support that skirt.

Item 7A1 - Prosecuting Attorney Kenneth Janssen has requested that his hourly rate be increased from \$145.00 per hour to \$165.00 per hour, effective January 1, 2025 with no cap. In the past few years, the annual cost was capped.

2019: 425.35 hours X \$125/hour = \$53,168.75 (Capped at \$50,000)

2020: 445.15 hours X \$125/hour = \$55,643.75 (Capped at **\$50,000**)

2021: 391.15 hours through **10/1/21** \$49,000 – (Capped at **\$50,000**)

2022: 480 hours X \$145/hour = \$69,600 (Capped at \$55,000) (\$114/hour)

2023: 504.9 hours X \$145/hour = \$73,080 (Capped at **\$60,000**) (\$119/hour)

2024: Jan-Sept 30, 2024 371.75 hours =\$53,903.75 (Capped at **\$60,000**) and estimate to end the year at approximately \$73,000.00

Currently, the Law Firm of Flaherty and Hood (Coalition of Greater MN Cities) has been billing the City of Glencoe at a rate of \$190.00/hour for labor relations services. Also, City Civil Attorney Mark Ostlund is billing the City at a rate of \$145.00/hour.

I am recommending that the City **should pay** the Prosecuting Attorney Fees of **\$165.00** per hour with no cap on the number of hours. I do not think that Prosecuting Attorney Office should be subsidizing the cost of City prosecutions.

A review of our records indicates that our current hourly rate had been lowered from \$145.00 to \$125.00 for criminal (prosecutions) matters in 2019. In 2019, the firm had additionally agreed to cap all criminal prosecution fees at \$50,000.00 per year for 3 years. We are now requesting to adjust the fee schedule to meet the changing needs of the City and our firm.

A review of the last three years shows that the firm has logged billable hours in the following amounts:

2019: 425.35 hours x \$125.00 = \$53,168.75 (Capped at \$50,000.00) 2020: 445.15 hours x \$125.00 = \$55,643.75 (Capped at \$50,000.00)

2021:391.15 hours (through September 30, 2021) x \$125.00 = \$48,893.75

As you can see, the 2019 adjustment has saved the City a considerable amount of money (over \$25,000.00 plus the remainder of this year to be provided nearly free of any further attorney fees). The firm is now requesting to modify the fee schedule to \$145.00 per hour, with a yearly cap of \$55,000.00 in 2022 and then \$60,000 in 2023 and 2024. If the new rate meets with the City's approval the new rate will commence on January 1, 2022. Please let me know if this increase is acceptable to the City of Glencoe. As always, your input is welcome. Please contact me if you wish to discuss the contents of this letter.

Gentlemen,

Just one last comment about the criminal attorney fees and my rough math. On average we are paying \$6024.04 per month. If you multiple that number by 12 that equals \$72,288.49 per year. Okay now if you add a 20 % increase to that cost for the increase per hour the attorney wants, you're looking at roughly an increase of \$14,457.70. Finally, if you add \$72,288.49 together with the wage increase of \$14,457.70 you are looking at a total of \$86,746.19.

We currently have a capped contract that stops at \$60,000. We have hit that max already and we still have two months to go. Just my rough estimate based off this year's costs and pay raise shows in increase of \$26,746.19.

Item 7D – It is recommended to approve the attached update contract with CEDA for 2025. This will include 2-days per week.

CEDA has assigned Michael Monson as the CEDA representative for Glencoe. Mike will have office hours in Glencoe on Tuesdays and Fridays each week. Mayor-elect Hueser, Council-elect Jon Dahlke, and EDA Chair Greg Ettel met with Mr. Monson on Friday December 13th and reviewed goals and objectives.

Contract for Professional Services

This contract is made and entered into by Community and Economic Development Associates, a Minnesota nonprofit corporation exempt from income tax as an organization operated for charitable purposes within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3), hereafter "CEDA", and the Economic Development Authority of the City of Glencoe, an agency or affiliate of a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota, hereafter "the Authority", to define the terms by which CEDA shall provide technical and management expertise services to the Authority.

- I. <u>Agreement scope and purpose</u>. The Authority hereby retains CEDA to perform to its benefit the services described in paragraph II, to the end of the Authority more effectively accomplishing:
 - * Prevention and/or combat of community and neighborhood deterioration and revitalization of deteriorated neighborhoods;
 - * Attraction and/or retention of businesses that would not, but for the assistance provided, choose to locate/remain in the area;
 - * The securing of businesses who will be required to provide jobs for unemployed and underemployed residents of the community; and
 - * The expansion of business opportunities for minority entrepreneurs and other entrepreneurs that are viable business opportunities to enhance the well being of the community and/or for businesses who are unable to obtain financing from conventional sources
- II. <u>Services to be provided by CEDA</u>. CEDA agrees to provide technical and management expertise in the form of staff and materials to the Authority. Staff's services, and associated materials, will be provided in order to facilitate and support the accomplishment of the Authority's undertakings to the ends described in the preceding paragraph. CEDA's staff and materials shall be made available toward efforts in the following specific arenas of the Authority's needs and operations:
 - * Accessing of grantor funding for the Authority's economic development programming
 - * Providing loan packaging services for the Authority's business assistance programs
 - * Administering local, regional and state revolving loan funds, if appropriate
 - * Drafting the Authority's Economic Development Annual Work Plan(s)
 - * Planning, facilitating, and/or directly conducting the Authority's community and business development projects, including as necessary, staffing those projects as directed by the Authority in consultation with CEDA. These efforts shall include (but are not limited to), the following:
 - * seeking city and county involvement
 - * developing relationships and partnerships to enhance the Authority's goals
 - * preparing economic development guidelines
 - * promoting the use of local assets to support and promote value-added processes and unique based businesses
 - * Assisting with local surveys related to business and industry, community, and land and buildings
 - * Assisting with the Authority's economic development marketing efforts and coordination through website development and maintenance
 - * Coordinating and hosting forums in which the Authority's economic development programming are open for the public's review

III. Obligations of the Authority.

- A. The Authority shall reimburse CEDA for staff time provided at the rate of \$53,580 not to exceed annually. This is based on an average of sixteen hours per week.
- B. Materials, conferences, meetings and the like shall be paid for on a unit basis agreed to by the Authority in writing prior to the provision of the materials.

C. The Authority shall be responsible to provide payment to CEDA within 30 days of the submission of each invoice provided by CEDA.

IV. Obligations of CEDA.

A. CEDA is performing services as an independent contractor. Accordingly, the provision of staff by CEDA to provide technical and management expertise to the Authority under this Agreement neither creates a release of CEDA staff to employment at the Authority nor makes such staff subject to supervision by the Authority.

B. CEDA has no authority or right, express or implied, to assume or create any obligation or responsibility on behalf of the Authority or to bind the Authority in any manner. CEDA will not

represent the contrary, either expressly or implicitly, to anyone.

- C. CEDA is solely responsible for payroll tax responsibilities related to each of its staff persons whose time is provided under this Agreement and shall acquire and maintain necessary insurance related to their efforts under this Agreement, including carrying workers' compensation insurance coverage at all times. CEDA shall supply the Authority with certification of such coverage.
- D. CEDA shall be responsible to invoice the Authority for staff time and materials provided under this Agreement on a periodic basis, no less frequently than quarterly.
- V. <u>Period/Termination</u>. The term of this Agreement is through December 31, 2025, commencing December 1, 2024. The Agreement may be terminated earlier in its term upon 30 days' written notice by CEDA to the Authority or by the Authority to CEDA. Upon termination, the Authority shall be liable to pay CEDA for services performed at \$53,580 per year and materials provided under this Agreement prior to and through the effective date of termination, unless otherwise specifically agreed by the parties in writing.
- VI. <u>Construction of Agreement</u>. This Agreement is to be performed and construed under Minnesota law, and supersedes any and all prior agreements and contains the entire agreement of the parties.
