The intersection of Hennepin Avenue and TH 22 (13th Street) is scheduled to be reopened on July 23rd. Advance warning signs are in place. The detour follows Armstrong Avenue and 7th Street E.

Upcoming work includes the following:

- 15th Street from Hennepin Avenue to Judd Avenue
 - CenterPoint Energy is continuing work on installing new gas lines.
 - All city-owned utilities have been installed.
 - Work cannot begin on street construction until the gas main work is complete. We appreciate your patience!
- Hennepin Avenue
 - Residents on Hennepin Avenue between 13th Street and 16th Street, expect no access.
 - Construction of water main from 13th Street to 16th Street is complete.
 - Sanitary sewer mainline will be constructed from 13th Street to 16th Street next week.
 - Underground utility work at TH22 intersection is complete and the contractor is rebuilding the road base. They will be paving the intersection early next week.
 - The 20th Street intersection will be closed beginning July 18th for the installation of underground utilities. This work will continue until the end of July.
 - Construction of storm sewer from 23rd Street heading south towards 20th Street continues next week.

Here is some additional information.

As water main work continues, look for notices on your doors for announcements of temporary water shutdowns. Shutdowns will be needed in various parts of the project as connections are made to the existing water system.

Please remember that schedules can change at a moment's notice because of weather or delays by private utility companies that are not under direct control of the City or the City's contractor.
