 Intersection paving is tentatively scheduled for August 20th, with the intersection anticipated to reopen August 21st. A one-day closure will be required in October for cut over of the temporary sanitary sewer.

Please remember that schedules can change at a moment's notice because of weather or delays by private utility companies that are not under direct control of the City or the City's contractor.

During construction, there will be times when streets are closed to traffic. Residents will need to park on adjacent streets and walk to their homes.
