SUMMARY OF JOB: The Streets & Parks Maintenance Worker performs manual labor and operates equipment to maintain and repair city streets, parks, and public grounds. Work includes mowing, tree care, basic facility upkeep, street maintenance, and seasonal tasks such as snow removal. The role ensures clean, safe, and well-maintained public spaces while working outdoors in all weather conditions.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain and repair city streets, parks, and public grounds through manual labor and equipment operation.
- Operate equipment, including loaders, trucks, mowers, sweepers, and hand tools, to complete street and park maintenance tasks.
- Work flexible hours for snowplowing or other maintenance tasks.
- Perform street maintenance activities, including patching, tarring, sealcoating, snow removal, and street sweeping.
- Maintain park areas by mowing, trimming, planting, fertilizing, and caring for trees, shrubs, and landscaped areas.
- Perform maintenance and basic repairs on department equipment and small engines.
- Maintain park buildings, playgrounds, ball fields, picnic areas, and other recreational facilities to ensure safe and functional public spaces
- Assist with general maintenance tasks, including debris cleanup, facility upkeep, and seasonal operations.
- Perform related duties as assigned or required to support overall department operations.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Valid driver's license or the ability to obtain one at the time of appointment.
- Class A CDL with air brakes and tanker endorsement or the ability to obtain one.

- Knowledge of basic methods, materials, tools, and practices used in street, park, and grounds maintenance.
- Ability to operate light and heavy equipment such as mowers, trucks, loaders, sweepers, and hand tools.
- Ability to perform manual labor in outdoor environments and in all weather conditions.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers and the public.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Working knowledge of operating street maintenance equipment.
- Working knowledge of minor repair and maintenance of equipment and small engines.
- Mechanical aptitude for basic troubleshooting and maintenance.
- Experience in tree trimming, landscaping, or grounds keeping.
- Experience with snow removal equipment and operations.
